

2019 New Member Advantage Program Restrictions (1 of 2)

(April, 2019 jmr2)

1. Bylaw restricting # of Golf and Tennis rounds allowable to social members is being reinstated on May 1, 2019 which states:

“Class C Social Membership-Must be a resident and a stockholder owning five (5) shares. The member or the family, whichever is applicable, shall have the use of the Corporations facilities except for use of the golf course and the tennis courts. Class C members may use the golf facilities once a month by paying current guest fees and Tennis facilities twice a month by paying current guest fees”.
2. Out-of-town members will be allowed to use all E/M facilities at guest fee rates not to exceed 40 days in one calendar year. Out of Town members are eligible for any new Member Advantage Program golf membership, including Social Golf I, II and III.
3. Any member maintaining a social membership for more than one calendar year is eligible for the New Member Recruitment Program at any full golf or social golf I, II or III membership level.
4. Golf members who have downgraded to a social membership within the past 12 months are eligible for Social Golf I, II or III programs or can return to their previous member status at any time without penalty.
5. Former members are eligible for New Member Advantage Program 1 year following their resignation anniversary and are eligible for all categories of the New Member Advantage Program.
6. Multiple discounts (other than referrals) are not available to new members under the New Member Advantage Program.

2019 New Member Advantage Program Restrictions (2 OF 2)

7. All referral discounts take effect one month after new member is entered into EMGCC's tracking system. Referral discounts cannot exceed the referred member's 24 or 36-month commitment.
8. All new member referral discounts end when referee downgrades, is not in good standing, goes on Leave of Absence (LOA) or terminates their membership.
9. New Member discounts end for referee if referring member downgrades, terminates their membership, are not in good standing or goes on Leave of Absence.
10. New Member referral discounts are not transferrable to other members or new members.
11. Dues referral discounts are not available to members unless member's referee is at an equal higher level of membership (i.e., a social can refer a full golf and qualify for a 10% dues discount but a full golf member cannot expect a 10% golf dues discount when referring a new social member).
12. Any new member signing a 24 or 36-month membership agreement will be subject to published 2017 Dues rates at the end of their signed obligation period.
13. All questions regarding the 2019 New Member Advantage Program should be put in writing and forwarded to the Business office for response. All questions and responses will be shared with the membership as necessary.
